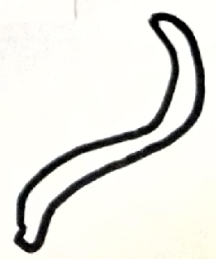


Cabbage Worms

Cabbage Worms aren't worms at all, they're actually Caterpillars! Cabbage worms are called "**Cabbage worms**" because they eat plants in the "brassica" family like *cabbage*, *broccoli*, and *kale*. Just like other caterpillars, cabbage worms have a special life cycle: they start as **eggs** and then grow into **caterpillars**, or "**larvae**," which is what we see on our cabbage plants. In the winter, the cabbage worms will make a **cocoon** inside the soil and become a "**pupae**." In the spring, they emerge from their cocoon as a cabbage **moth**!

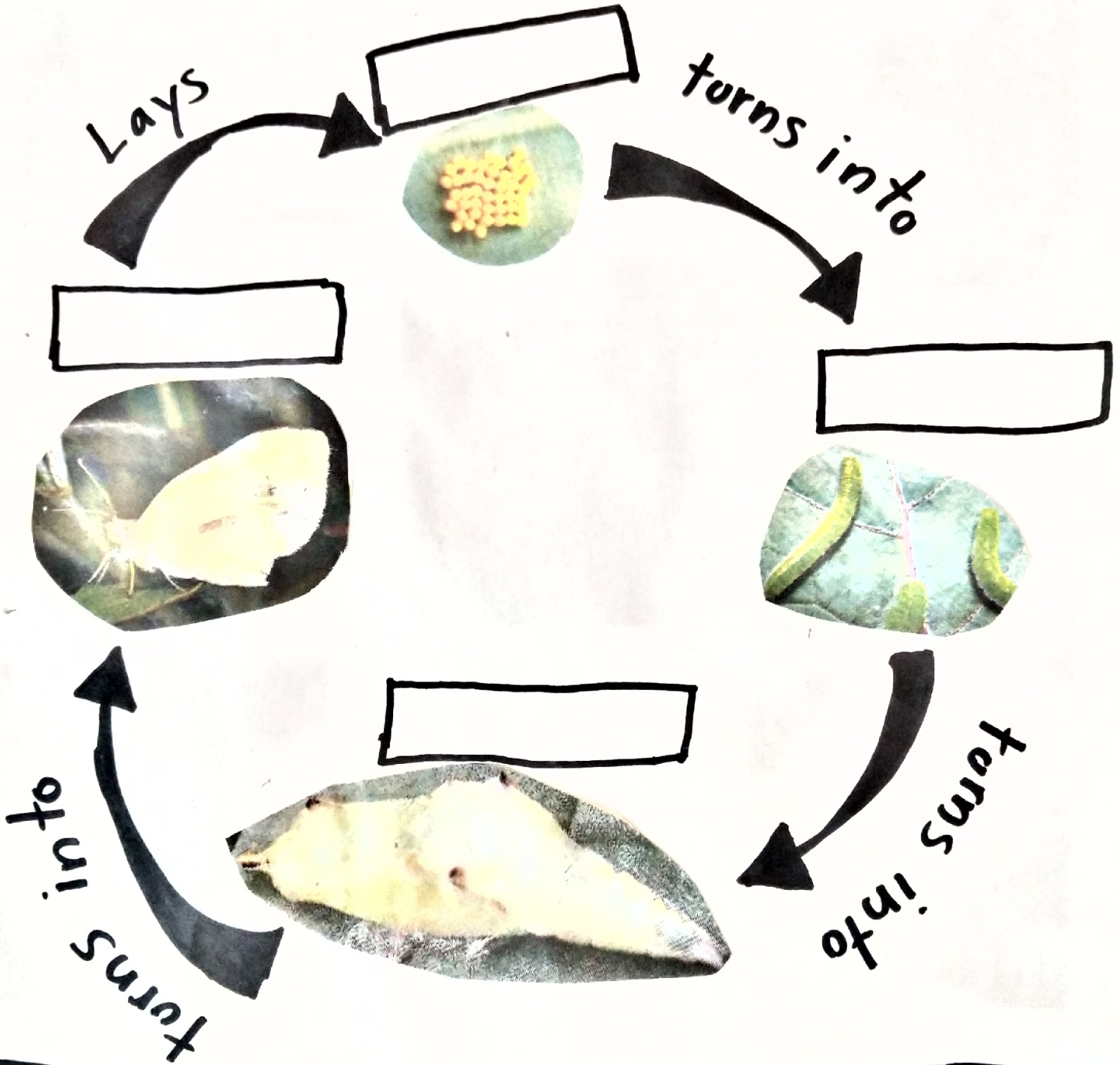
